Highways & Byways

It has been announced that Schull will be the recipients of a very generous €10,000 for **Christmas Lights** from West Cork Municipal District council. A committee (from S&DCC and SB&TA) are liaising with the CCC and looking into procuring lights for this Christmas.

The **CCTV** contracts have been signed and work on the installation will begin shortly and it is anticipated that they will be up and running by Christmas.

The S&DCC is liaising with our local CC office with a view to addressing the crucial **parking** question. They will be looking into amending the bylaws and making changes to the yellow lines. It is hoped that before the season starts again next year there will be more equitable and safe (it is vital that emergency vehicles have a clear passage through the village at all times) parking on the Main Street.
