Keeping Schull Clean Dog Owners

The Green Dog Walkers program is a new initiative in Schull as Dog Fouling is a major issue in and around the town. It's a community led program involving, Scoil Mhuire National School, The Little Way Charity and Harbour Bay Flower Shop. The program is a positive, friendly way to change attitudes about dog fouling.

Scoil Mhuire National School students have created a number of posters promoting the initiative. Free dog pick up bag dispensers will be available in The Harbour Bay Flower Shop, Main Street, Schull. We ask people to pledge to

- 1- Clean up after your dog
- 2- Carry extra dog waste bags
- 3- Be happy to be approached to "lend" a waste bag to those without
- 4- Be a friendly reminder to other dog walkers to clean up after their dogs.

Section 22 of the Litter Pollution Act 1997 to 2009 requires that a person in charge of a dog shall immediately remove dog faeces from a public place or face an on the spot fine of €150. The maximum court fine is €3000.
